Acts 26:16

On Saturday, June 24, 2019, at the XI International Youth Forum, Pope Francis announced to the audience the triennial itinerary of World Youth Day.

As reported by the Dicastery for the Laity, Family and Life, the theme chosen by the Holy Father for the Diocesan World Youth Day WYD 2021-2022 is "Stand up. I appoint you as a witness of what you have seen!"(cf. Acts 26:16)

This spiritual path marked by the Pontiff continues in coherence with the reflection begun at the last World Youth Day in Panama in 2019 and with the synodal journey, in particular with the Apostolic Exhortation <u>CHRISTUS</u> <u>VIVIT</u>.

This theme aligns with and further strengthens the call to young people to "*Rise* Up," to hasten to live the Lord's call and spread the Good News, as the Virgin Mary did after having pronounced "Here I am." The verb "to rise" in the original text of St. Luke also has the meaning of "to rise again," "to awaken to life."

ORGANIZING ENTITY:

The Ramón Pané Foundation organizes and convenes the VIDEO CONTEST Challenge WYD 2022.

GENERAL GOAL: To animate the theme of reflection that Pope Francis proposed for diocesan **WYD 2021-2022** through the arts in music, song and dance, using the New Evangelization with creativity and innovation with the best of young people's talents for the Service of the Lord in the Church thereby letting this message take action in their lives both inside and outside the Church.







Contest Rules

1. PARTICIPANTS:

- 1. Individuals between the ages of 18 and 35 years old.
- 2. People of other ages may participate if they include individuals as described in point 1.

2. CONTEST RULES:

- 1. Participants must prepare, create, and record a Video Challenge with choreography using the song: "JESÚS ME DIJO: Levanta-te! iLevántate! Get Up!" [Hear and watch the video by clicking OFFICIAL VIDEO. You can also watch the the video with the lyrics by clicking here: VIDEO WITH LYRICS].
- 2. The minimum number of participants is 5 young people; this can include adults, adolescents, and children [Minor (under 18 years) participants must have an appointed adult who assumes responsibility and gives authorization to participate].
- 3. Video must be horizontal landscape 16:9 ratio.
- 4. The video must be in the best possible quality (resolution).
- 5. Video production is free.
- 6. The style of choreography is free.
- 7. VIDEOS THAT USE VULGAR LANGUAGE AND/OR BODY MOVEMENTS OR ANY OTHER SUBJECT MATTER THAT GOES AGAINST GOOD VALUES AND PRINCIPLES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. [Each video will be evaluated to verify that it meets the established parameters (Doctrine and Morals) of the Church.]
- 8. Register by completing the forms found online at <u>www.cristonautas.com</u>. Provide all the required information.
- 9. Send the video through any of the different platforms to <u>cristonautas@cristonautas.com</u> via

- 10. Upon registration you will receive a reply email confirming your participation in the contest.
- 11. The organizing entity will upload the videos to YouTube, Facebook, and Instagram with the Hashtags: #challengejmj2022, #challengewyd2022, #cristonautasfrp.







- 12. Any video that is approved of will be added to the playlists on the Cristonautas site and Social Networks, as well as those of our sponsors. These videos will be the only ones considered to compete.
- 13. The organizing entity will provide the participants the links corresponding to their videos.
- 14. The participants can invite the entire public to like their videos on social networks and to become a follower of the organizers and sponsors. This way, the total count of "likes" as followers will be validated and verified.

- 1. Start date: Thursday, September 8th, 2022 [Feast of the Nativity of the Virgin Mary].
- 2. Closing date: Thursday, November 16th, 2022.
- 3. Winner Announcement Date: Sunday, November 20th, 2022. [Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe]

6. AWARDS AND RECOGNITIONS:

1. All participants will receive a digital diploma of recognition for their participation.
